KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH

ORDINANCE 82-62

CREATING THE POSITION OF DELINQUENT ACCOUNTS CLERK AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS FOR THAT POSITION WITHIN THE FINANCE DEPARTMENT OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH.

WHEREAS, the Kenai Peninsula Borough has in excess of forty-five thousand accounts including oil property, real property, personal property, sales tax and land sale accounts; and

WHEREAS, a certain percentage of these accounts are delinquent; and

WHEREAS, these delinquencies, if left uncollected for a period of time, become lost revenues of the Borough and cities within the Borough; and

WHEREAS, the Finance Department does not have sufficient manpower to effectively monitor delinquent accounts and employ collection procedures where necessary; and

WHEREAS, an additional individual specifically assigned to the collection of delinquent accounts is necessary to insure revenues are not lost;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That a new position entitled Delinquent Accounts Clerk, salary range 11, be created in the Finance Department to monitor and initiate collection proceedings on all tax and land sale accounts.

Section 2. That \$31,800 be appropriated from the unappropriated reserve to Finance Department Revenue Division (1440-0100 and 8100) to cover the costs of salary, fringe benefits and equipment for this position.

Section 3. That this ordinance takes effect upon its enactment.
