KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH

ORDINANCE 82-71

ESTABLISHING THE POSITION OF A DEPUTY BOROUGH ATTORNEY.

WHEREAS, it has been determined that the workload in the Borough Legal Department requires the attention of two full-time attorneys; and

WHEREAS, the Assembly established a paralegal position in the Legal Department; and

WHEREAS, a paralegal could not represent the Borough in court; and

WHEREAS, no funding is needed for this position as funds are available in a contract services account;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the paralegal position in the Legal Department be deleted.

Section 2. That the position of deputy attorney be established at a salary range not to exceed \$50,000 annually.

Section 3. That the Borough Attorney's salary be established at a rate not to exceed \$60,000 annually.


Section 4. That the position of deputy attorney is approved.

Section 5. That this ordinance takes effect on the date of its enactment.
