KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH

ORDINANCE 82-75

AMENDING SECTION 1.20.030 OF THE BOROUGH CODE TO PROVIDE THAT THE PURCHASE ORDERS FOR EQUIPMENT FOR NEW SCHOOL FACILITIES SHALL BE ISSUED WITHIN NINE MONTHS AFTER THE SCHOOL FACILITY HAS BEEN OCCUPIED BY THE BOROUGH.

WHEREAS, current Section 1.20.030 of the Borough Code provides that all purchase orders respecting approved equipment lists for a new school shall be issued within six months after the Borough has occupied the facility; and

WHEREAS, experience has indicated that the six month purchase period is too short to allow the most economical possible procurement of new equipment and the determination of the most appropriate equipment for the facility; and

WHEREAS, the Borough School District has requested that Section 1.20.030 (A) (7) be amended to provide that purchase orders shall be issued within nine months after occupancy of the school rather than the current six month period;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That Subsection 1.20.030 (A) (7) is amended to read:

7. All purchase orders respecting approved equipments lists will be issued within [six] nine months after the school facility has been turned over to the Borough for beneficial occupancy.

Section 2. That this Ordinance takes effect immediately upon its enactment.
