KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH

EMERGENCY ORDINANCE 82-79

APPROVING THE EMERGENCY PURCHASE OF A 275 KILOWATT DIESEL GENERATOR FOR THE BOROUGH ADMINISTRATION BUILDING.

WHEREAS, the existing generator used for auxiliary power at the Borough Administration Building has a rated output of 150 kilowatts; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Administration Building and its associated computer system currently requires approximately 190 kilowatts to maintain normal operations; and

WHEREAS, the lack of an adequate power supply can cause damage to the Burrough's computer should the public utility power source fail, and could result in the loss of essential data; and

WHEREAS, Industry Services, Inc., is the sole supplier for the purchase of a Kohler diesel generator and can deliver the generator in the near future; and

WHEREAS, Industry Services, Inc., has agreed to provide a complete generator for the cost of \$37,500, and sufficient funds are available; and

WHEREAS, the Assembly finds that in the likelihood of a power failure, the associated loss of irreplaceable tax data and other data constitutes an emergency which requires an immediate action;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the Assembly hereby finds that the existing power supply at the Borough is inadequate, and that the likelihood of an imminent power failure and data loss constitutes an emergency within the provisions of AS 29.43.160.

Section 2. That the sum of \$37,500 is appropriated from the General Fund Unappropriated Surplus to the Capital Projects Acct. No. 001-41990-7605 to be used for the purchase of a 275 kilowatt Kohler generator for the Borough Administration Building.

Section 3. That the proposal of Industry Services, Inc., the sole source for this generator, is accepted and a contract is awarded for the purchase of the auxiliary generator together

with all necessary associated equipment for a cost not to exceed \$37,500.

Section 4. That this ordinance takes effect immediately upon its enactment.
