KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH

ORDINANCE 82-80

AUTHORIZING THE RECEIPT OF \$1,000,000 STATE MUNICIPAL AID FOR MUNICIPALITIES PROVIDED BY HC SCSHB 148 (FINANCE) CHAPTER 101 1982 FOR BOROUGH ROAD CAPITAL PROJECTS.

WHEREAS, the State of Alaska has notified the Kenai Peninsula Borough that the sum of \$1,000,000 has been allocated to the Borough from the State of Alaska Municipal Aid Fund for the development of capital projects; and

WHEREAS, HC SHB 148 (Finance) 1982 Session requires that the legislative body enact an ordinance authorizing the municipality to receive and spend the money provided by the entitlement; and

WHEREAS, the Borough, by separate resolution, is providing a list of all capital projects to be completed on receipt of the entitlement;


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the Mayor is authorized to accept a grant in the amount of \$1,000,000 as provided under HCS HB 148 (Finance) 1982 Session.

Section 2. Estimated revenue entitled State Municipal Aid is increased by the sum of \$1,000,000, and the appropriation in the Municipal Aid Fund Capital Projects is increased by \$1,000,000 to be charged to Account No. 68-21001-9007.

Section 3. That this ordinance takes effect immediately upon its enactment.
