KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH

ORDINANCE 82-89

APPROVING THE PURCHASE OF AN UNINTERRUPTIBLE POWER SOURCE FOR THE BOROUGH COMPUTER, AND APPROPRIATION OF \$80,000 FROM FEDERAL REVENUE SHARING FUNDS FOR THAT PURPOSE.

WHEREAS, the Kenai Peninsula Borough is heavily computerized; and

WHEREAS, any computer outage causes serious work disruption, making the reconstruction of computer files necessary; and

WHEREAS, sharp fluctuations in power can do harm to the computer; and

WHEREAS, sufficient funds are available in the Borough Federal Revenue Sharing Fund to purchase and install an uninterruptible power system; and

WHEREAS, an administrative public hearing was held on November 15, 1982, in accordance with Federal regulations;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the Mayor is authorized to purchase and install an uninterruptible power system in an amount not to exceed \$80,000.

Section 2. That Federal Revenue Sharing funds in the amount of \$80,000 are appropriated from the Federal Revenue Sharing Fund unappropriated balance to the Federal Shared Revenue Special Activity Equipment Account #006.41810.8300.

Section 3. That this ordinance takes effect immediately upon its enactment.
