ORDINANCE 83-15

AMENDING KPB 1.20.030 A 7 TO PROVIDE FOR AN EXCEPTION APPROVED BY RESOLUTION OF THE ASSEMBLY FROM THE REQUIREMENT THAT PURCHASE ORDERS FOR EQUIPMENT LISTS SHOULD BE ISSUED WITHIN TWENTY-FOUR MONTHS AFTER THE SCHOOL FACILITY HAS BEEN TURNED OVER FOR BENEFICIAL OCCUPANCY, AND CLARIFYING THE REQUIREMENT.

WHEREAS, KPB 1.20.030 A 7 provides that purchase orders of approved equipment lists "will" be issued within twenty-four months after the school facility has been turned over to the Borough for beneficial occupancy, and it is apparently intended therein that this is a requirement for payment and the word "must" would be more clear than the use of the word "will"; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That KPB 1.20.030 A 7 is hereby amended as follows:

- 7. All purchase orders respecting approved equipment lists <u>must</u> [WILL] be issued within <u>twenty-four</u> [NINE] months after the school facility has been turned over to the borough for beneficial occupancy.
- Section 2. That the authority granted by the change in ordinance contained in Section 1 above shall be made retroactive so that the Assembly may approve any expenditures of funds for equipment in the past where circumstances uphold the necessity or wisdom of delaying said purchases.

Section 3. That this ordinance shall be effective immediately upon passage.
