KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH

ORDINANCE 83-31

AUTHORIZING THE RECEIPT AND APPROPRIATION OF A \$400,000 GRANT FROM THE UNITED STATES FOREST SERVICE FOR THE PURPOSE OF CONSTRUCTING EXIT GLACIER ROAD (FORMERLY RESURRECTION RIVER ROAD).

WHEREAS, the U. S. Department of Agriculture Forest Service has notified the Borough of a grant of \$400,000 for the purpose of constructing Exit Glacier Road (formerly known as Resurrection River Road); and

WHEREAS, the engineering plans will be completed by June 1, 1983; and

WHEREAS, the Forest Service must commit these funds by construction contract prior to September 30 or return them to the Federal government's general fund;


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the sum of \$400,000 is accepted from the U.S. Department of Agriculture Forest Service for the purposes of constructing Exit Glacier Road (formerly known as Resurrection River Road).

Section 2. That \$400,000 is appropriated to Capital Projects Account No. 69-21043-9210.

Section 3. That this ordinance takes effect immediately upon its enactment.
