ORDINANCE 83-34 (SUBSTITUTE)

AMENDING KPB 2.08.130 TO CONSOLIDATE PROCEDURES CONCERNING PUBLIC PRESENTATIONS OF AGENDA ITEMS IN SUBSECTION "A", AND CONCERNING FORMAL PRESENTATIONS OF NON-AGENDA ITEMS IN SUBSECTION "B", AND EXPANDING PUBLIC PRESENTATIONS AFFECTING AN INDIVIDUAL OR AGENT AND PROVIDING FOR ADDITIONAL TIME UPON REQUESTED PRIVILEGE.

WHEREAS, KPB 2.08.130 does not provide for the granting of Assembly privilege to permit a member of the public to speak tor more than three minutes; and

WHEREAS, the section does not limit a person with a direct interest from having multiple agents; and

WHEREAS, KPB 2.08.130 as written, combines formal presentations of matters not on the agenda with public presentations of matters on the agenda;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That Section 2.08.130 of the Kenai Peninsula Borough Code of Ordinances is hereby repealed and reenacted as follows:

- 2.08.130 Public presentations--Requirements. A. A public presentation may be made without prior notice concerning legislation then being considered by the Assembly in the form of an ordinance or resolution when the Assembly considers the specific legislative item as follows:
 - 1. Any person who would be directly and substantially affected by the proposed legislation shall have a reasonable time not to exceed 30 minutes to make a presentation individually or by agent, provided that the president shall not permit the restatement of issues or facts once presented by that person or agent other than by summary, and providing further that the president may permit an additional minute period for presentation upon request of any assembly member; and
 - 2. Any other person may make an individual public presentation, individually or by agent, not exceeding 3 minutes provided however that any assembly member may request privilege to permit an additional 3 minutes of presentation by any individual concerning that legislative item. The 3 minute limita-

tion and all privilege extensions shall be strictly enforced by the president.

Any member of the public desiring to make a formal presentation before the Borough Assembly at a regular meeting concerning a subject not contained in the Assembly's agenda for that meeting shall give 6 days notice to the Borough Clerk and state the subject of the presentation. The total time permitted for formal presentations with prior notice concerning a subject not contained in the Assembly's agenda for that meeting shall be limited to 10 minutes per topic, regardless of the number of persons participating in the presentation. The Assembly president may, with the concurrence of a majority of the Assembly, allow for additional time. This time limit shall not apply to formal presentations made at the request of the Mayor or the Assembly. This section does not preclude the Borough Clerk from scheduling presentations which will exceed 10 minutes prior to the beginning of an assembly meeting or before the Assembly as a committee of the whole. Any other formal presentations shall be made as approved in the agenda.

 $\underline{\text{Section 2}}.$ That this ordinance shall become effective immediately on the date of its enactment.
