ORDINANCE 83-36

PROVIDING FOR THE RETENTION OF MONIES OTHERWISE OWING TO PERSONS
OR ENTITIES HAVING UNSATISFIED TAX OBLIGATIONS.

WHEREAS, the Borough may from time to time be obligated by
contract or otherwise to pay certain sums to individuals or
entities who have unsatisfied Borough tax obligations;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI
PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the Kenai Peninsula Borough Code of
Ordinances is hereby amended by adding a new section to be
numbered 5.08.035 which shall read as follows:

5.08.035 Prohibiting payment to persons owing taxes.
Notwithstanding other provisions of this code, no
payment will be made to any person or entity having an
unsatisfied tax obligation or unsatisfied judgment owed
to the borough except for amounts owed to said person
or entity in excess of the obligation to the borough.

Section 2. That this ordinance takes effect immediately on
the date of its enactment.
