KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH

ORDINANCE 83-37

AMENDING KPB 16.08 TO CLARIFY THE AUTHORIZED POWERS OF THE CENTRAL KENAI PENINSULA HOSPITAL SERVICE AREA.

WHEREAS, the Central Kenai Peninsula Hospital Service Area was established by Ordinance 69-3 adopted March 4, 1969, and was authorized to construct, maintain, and operate a hospital or hospitals by special election on April 8, 1969, called by Resolution 69-5 R as indicated by Resolution 69-14 R acknowledging receipt of the certificate of the canvassing board and declaring passage of the proposition; and

WHEREAS, at the regular election of October 5, 1976, the electorate approved the proposition placed on the ballot by Ordinance 76-47 to amend the powers of the Central Kenai Peninsula Hospital Service Area to include the authority to establish and to operate, or to participate in the expense of operating, a center for the treatment of alcoholism subject to such conditions as may be established by ordinance of the Kenai Peninsula Borough; and


WHEREAS, neither the original authority nor the amended authority has been codified in the Kenai Peninsula Borough ordinances;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That KPB 16.08 is hereby amended by adding a new section, KPB 16.08.015 which shall read as follows:

16.08.015 Authorized functions of the Central Peninsula Hospital Service Area. The Central Kenai Peninsula Hospital Service Area is authorized to construct, maintain, and operate a hospital or hospitals and to establish and to operate, or to participate in the expense of operating, a center for the treatment of alcoholism, subject to such conditions as may be established by ordinance of the Kenai Peninsula Borough.
