ORDINANCE 83-48

ESTABLISHING THE ANCHOR POINT FIRE AND EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICE AREA TO PROVIDE FIRE PROTECTION AND AMBULANCE SERVICES, AND PROVIDING FOR AN ELECTED BOARD.

WHEREAS, more than 15% of the voters of the area around Anchor Point, and which would be affected by the petition, have by petition requested the establishment of a fire and ambulance service area district in an area described by the petition; and

WHEREAS, such services cannot be provided by an existing service area, by annexation to a city, or by incorporation as a city:

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. Title 16 of the Kenai Peninsula Borough Code of Ordinances is amended by adding a new Chapter 16.48, and shall read as follows:

Chapter 16.48 Anchor Point Fire and Emergency Medical Service Area

16.48.010 Boundaries. There is hereby established a service area within the Kenai Peninsula Borough designated as the "Anchor Point Fire and Emergency Medical Service Area," in that portion of the Borough described as follows:

All lands easterly of the easterly mean high waterline of Cook Inlet within:

Sections 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 22, 23, 24, 25, 26, 27, 33, 34, 35, 36, T4S, R15W, S.M.

Sections 27, 28, 29, 30, 31, 32, 33, 34, T4S, R14W, S.M.

Sections 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, T5S, R15W, S.M.

Sections 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 16, 17, 18, T5S, R14W, S.M.

16.48.020 Board of directors. A. There is hereby established a board of directors for the Anchor Point

Fire and Emergency Medical Service Area composed of five (5) members who shall be nominated and elected by the qualified voters of the service area in the manner provided for candidates for the Assembly in the Borough Code of Ordinances, except that members of the board shall be residents of the Borough within the service area.

- B. The board shall meet periodically at regular and special meetings called by the board. All meetings shall be open to the public as provided by law.
- 16.48.030 Terms and qualifications. A member of the board of directors shall be elected for a term of three (3) years and shall serve until his successor has been elected and sworn to assume the duties of the office, except that the first board shall contain staggered terms as designated in the resolution providing for the election.
- 16.48.040 Powers and duties. The board of directors of the service area, subject to Assembly approval, and appropriation of funds, shall supervise the establishment and operation of the fire and emergency medical services within the service area, and shall advise the Mayor and the Assembly concerning the administration and operation of the service area.
- <u>Section 2</u>. In the event that the service area is approved by the voters in the service area, the Assembly shall enact an ordinance providing for the organization and the rules and regulations to govern the service area.
- Section 3. This ordinance takes effect immediately upon its enactment, and upon approval by the voters of the service area at the special Borough election to be held on October 4, 1983.
