KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH  
ORDINANCE 83-71 (SUBSTITUTE)

AUTHORIZING THE EXPENDITURE OF \$3,646,900 OF BOROUGH FUNDS FOR THE PROPOSED ADDITIVE ALTERNATES FOR THE HOMER HIGH SCHOOL TO CONSTRUCT, IMPROVE AND EQUIP THE VOCATIONAL AGRICULTURE SHOP, PHYSICAL EDUCATION AREA, REHEARSAL AND DRESSING AREA ADJACENT TO THE AUDITORIUM, AUTO MECHANICS SHOP AND SWIMMING POOL.

WHEREAS, competitive bids have been solicited and received for the proposed additive alternates; and

WHEREAS, Proposition No. 6 authorizing the sale of bonds for the Homer High School additive alternates has been approved at the October 4, 1983 election; and

WHEREAS, it is in the Borough's best interest to award and construct the additive alternates.

WHEREAS, the authorization of the contract for the construction of Homer High School will include the \$3,228,000 figure for alternates 1 through 5 plus \$418,900 for movable equipment associated with those alternates for a total of \$3,646,900.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the sum of \$3,646,900 is hereby appropriated from the unappropriated balance of the Borough central treasury for the purpose of funding the proposed additive alternates for the Homer High School to construct, improve and equip the vocational agriculture shop, physical education area, auditorium, rehearsal and dressing area, auto mechanics shop, and swimming pool.

The expenditures authorized by this ordinance shall be returned to the central treasury of the Borough from the proceeds of the sale of the school bonds after the school bond issue is funded; and these authorized expenditures shall properly be accounted for in the respective school projects.


Section 2. The furnishing and equipment budget is increased by \$418,900.

Section 3. That this ordinance takes effect immediately upon its enactment.
