KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH

ORDINANCE 83-91

AUTHORIZING THE RECEIPT OF \$80,936 GRANT FROM THE STATE OF ALASKA, DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY, FOR THE PURCHASE OF SIGNS AND POSTS FOR THE IDENTIFICATION OF STREETS AND INTERSECTIONS OUTSIDE THE CITIES WITHIN THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH AND TO PROVIDE FOR SERVICE AREA FUNDING OF SIGN INSTALLATIONS.

WHEREAS, the State of Alaska, Department of Public Safety, has tendered a grant offered to the Kenai Peninsula Borough for the purchase of street signs and posts; and

WHEREAS, service areas have tentatively agreed to provide matching funds for the installation of the signs and posts;

WHEREAS, these signs will serve to reduce response time of those agencies responding to an emergency and will improve incoming data to 911 dispatch concerning location of any emergency incident; and

WHEREAS, these grant funds will be subject to a financial and conformance audit;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:


Section 1. That the Mayor is authorized to accept the grant of \$80,936 from the Department of Public Safety to purchase the signs and posts at such time as the service areas involved have provided funding for the installation.

Section 2. That all expenditures for the purchase and installation of these signs shall be charged to account #071.47250-.3500.

Section 3. That to provide adequate information for financial and performance audit required on this grant, all contracts for installation of signs will be advertised and administered by the Finance Department.

Section 4. That this ordinance takes effect immediately upon its enactment.
