ORDINANCE 85-1

APPROPRIATING FUNDS TO PROCEED THROUGH THE SCHEMATIC PHASES OF ARCHITECTURAL SERVICES FOR THE PROPOSED ANCHOR POINT JUNIOR HIGH SCHOOL PROJECT.

WHEREAS, it appears desirable to complete the schematic documents for the proposed Anchor Point Junior High School Project; and

WHEREAS, architectural services for the schematic phase can be completed in time for consideration for the 1985 bond issue, and;

WHEREAS, time is of the essence and early completion of the schematic documents may result in improved project evaluation;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the sum of \$190,387 is hereby appropriated from the unappropriated balance of the Borough central treasury for the purpose of funding the schematic phase for the Anchor Point Jr. High School project to Account #401-710101-49999-85106.

Section 2. That the Mayor is hereby authorized to utilize these funds for the completion of the schematic documents and necessary soils and surveys investigations. All sums shall be expended in accordance with the contract approved for this project. The expenditures authorized by this ordinance shall be returned to the central treasury of the Borough from the proceeds of the sale of the school bonds after the school bond issue is funded; and these authorized expenditures shall properly be accounted for in the respective school project.

Section 3. That this ordinance takes effect immediately upon its enactment.
