KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH

ORDINANCE 85-9

APPROPRIATING AND AUTHORIZING THE EXPENDITURE OF \$41,900 OF BOROUGHS FUNDS TO PROCEED THROUGH THE CONSTRUCTION DOCUMENTS AND CONSTRUCTION INSPECTION PHASE OF ARCHITECTURAL SERVICES FOR THE RENOVATION OF HOMER MIDDLE SCHOOL (TO AN ELEMENTARY FACILITY).

WHEREAS, the Kenai Peninsula Borough Assembly Resolution 84-156 authorized architectural schematic design and construction cost estimate services for Homer Middle School and former Homer High School; and

WHEREAS, the Kenai Peninsula Borough Assembly approved Resolution 84-103 for \$50,000 planning funds; and

WHEREAS, the funding for schematic design, construction cost estimate and design development architectural phases will have been exhausted by action date of this resolution; and

WHEREAS, time is of essence in order to continue with and complete the contract documents phase and to take advantage of favorable construction bidding season in 1985;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:


Section 1. That the sum of \$41,900 is hereby appropriated from the unappropriated balance of the general fund to the Homer Middle School project account #401-720300-49999-84228.

Section 2. That the Mayor is hereby authorized to utilize these funds for the completion of the architectural phases for proposed public school renovation project named in Section 1. of this ordinance. All sums shall be expended in accordance with the contract previously approved for this project.


Section 3. That this appropriation shall be reimbursed to the general fund from the proceeds of any grants or from the proceeds of the sale of any bonds for these projects.

Section 4. That this ordinance takes effect immediately upon its enactment.
