ORDINANCE 85-15

AMENDING KPB CHAPTER 10.18 BY ADDING SECTIONS REQUIRING A BOROUGH LICENSE FOR SALE OF FIREWORKS AND SETTING THE PROCEDURE FOR LICENSING.

WHEREAS, the sale and use of fireworks within the Kenai Peninsula Borough is found to be an action properly subject to regulation by the Kenai Peninsula Borough to protect the health and safety of the public;

WHEREAS, in order to properly regulate and control the sale of fireworks, it is necessary that the borough have specific information as to the identity of sellers and location of all stands selling such fireworks; and

WHEREAS, in order to obtain such necessary information in a timely manner, the assembly finds it necessary to require licensing of each such fireworks stand and vendor;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That chapter 10.18 of the KPB Code of Ordinances is hereby amended by the addition of new section which is hereby enacted to read:

10.18.030 License for sale required. A. It is required that each individual stand or store selling fireworks must obtain and publicly exhibit a license for sale of fireworks from the Kenai Peninsula Borough. A person seeking a license for sale of fireworks must meet the following requirements:

1. The owner or principal operator of the fireworks stand must personally appear at the Borough building in Soldotna to obtain a license for sale.

2. The owner must be 18 years of age or older and must present a current state permit for sale of fireworks including endorsement by the state fire marshal as set out by AS 18.72.020.

3. That a license for sale of fireworks during the year 1985 must be acquired prior to May 1, 1985. In all future years licenses for sale of fireworks shall be available only if applied for during the month of January.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its enactment.
