ORDINANCE 85-19

APPROPRIATING AND AUTHORIZING THE EXPENDITURE OF \$635,580 TO PROCEED THROUGH THE DESIGN DEVELOPMENT PHASE OF ARCHITECTURAL AND PROJECT MANAGEMENT SERVICES FOR THE PROPOSED NIKISKI HIGH SCHOOL AND CENTRAL PENINSULA HIGH SCHOOL.

WHEREAS, the Kenai Peninsula Borough Assembly authorized architectural services for the Schematics design and comprehensive cost projection phase for these projects by adoption of the following resolutions:

WHEREAS, architectural design development services are required to finalize the comprehensive cost for each of the subject projects prior to placement on the October 1985 Bond Ballot;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the sum of \$635,580 is hereby appropriated from the Borough General Fund account #100-949010-47401 and transferred into the following project accounts:


New Nikiski High School	401-710802-49999	\$ 317,790
New South of Soldotna High	401-711800-49999	\$ 317,790
Total		\$ 635,580

Section 2. That the Mayor is hereby authorized to utilize these funds for the completion of the design development phases for each of the proposed public school projects specified in Section 1 of this ordinance. All sums shall be expended in accordance with the contracts previously approved for each of those projects.


Section 3. That the appropriations and expenditures authorized for each project by this ordinance shall be returned to the general fund of the Borough from any grant funds or from the proceeds of the sale of school bonds for that project.

Section 4. That this ordinance takes effect immediately upon enactment.
