ORDINANCE 85-20

SUBSTITUTE

AUTHORIZING THE EXPENDITURE OF \$94,560 OF BOROUGH FUNDS TO PROCEED THROUGH THE DESIGN DEVELOPMENT PHASE WITH ARCHITECTURAL FIRM OF MCGLOTHLIN BALIVET AND PROJECT MANAGER FIRM OF MORRISON KNUDSEN FOR THE NEW SOLDOTNA ELEMENTARY SCHOOL ADDITION.

WHEREAS, the Kenai Peninsula Borough Assembly adopted Resolution 85-1 authorizing the architectural firm of McGlothlin Balivet Co. to provide schematic design services for Soldotna Elementary School Addition; and

WHEREAS, architectural design development services are required to finalize the comprehensive construction cost for Soldotna Elementary School addition;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the sum of \$94,560 is hereby appropriated from the Borough General Fund account #100-949010-47401 and transferred into Soldotna Elementary School account #401-760100-49999.


Section 2. That the Mayor is hereby authorized to utilize these funds for the completion of the design development phases. All sums shall be expended in accordance with the contract previously approved.

Section 3. That the Mayor is authorized to approve Morrison Knudsen Co. as project managers on this project.

Section 4. That the appropriation and expenditures authorized by this ordinance shall be returned to the General Fund of the Borough from any grant funds or from the proceeds of the sale of school bonds for this project.

Section 5. That this ordinance takes effect immediately upon its enactment.
