KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH

ORDINANCE 85-21 (SUBSTITUTE)

APPROPRIATING \$80,000 FROM THE UNDESIGNATED FUND BALANCE TO THE NORTH PENINSULA RECREATIONAL SERVICE AREA FOR POOL REPAIRS AND FOR CONCEPTUAL PROGRAMMING AND SCHEMATIC DESIGN OF A NEW RECREATIONAL FACILITY.

WHEREAS, the North Peninsula Recreation Area (NPRSA) requires \$50,000 to repair their swimming pool; and

WHEREAS, the NPRSA requires \$30,000 to commence conceptual programming and schematic design of a new recreational facility; and

WHEREAS, funds in the amount of \$80,000 are available in the undesignated fund balance from unappropriated interest earnings; and

WHEREAS, the NPRSA has requested the Assembly to appropriate these funds.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That \$50,000 from the undesignated fund balance be appropriated to the NPRSA's capital account 459-611010-49999-85951 for pool repairs.


Section 2. That \$30,000 from the undesignated fund balance be appropriated to the NPRSA's capital account 459-611030-49999-85953 for conceptual programming and schematic design of a new recreational facility.

Section 3. That this ordinance takes effect immediately upon its enactment.
