KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH

ORDINANCE 85-23

DELEGATING TO THE CITY OF SOLDOTNA THE POWER TO PROVIDE ZONING REGULATION WITHIN THE CITY, AND REPEALING KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH CHAPTER 21.72.

WHEREAS, under the authority of AS 29.33.070(b)(2), the Kenai Peninsula Borough has enacted Kenai Peninsula Borough 21.01.020 providing that the Assembly will delegate power to provide zoning regulations in a city if requested by resolution of the city council; and

WHEREAS, the City of Soldotna has adopted Resolution 85-5 requesting that the Kenai Peninsula Borough Assembly delegate to the City of Soldotna the power to provide zoning regulation within the city; and

WHEREAS, the City of Soldotna has adopted Ordinance 367 which, creates Chapter 17.03 in the Soldotna City Code of Ordinances to regulate zoning within the City of Soldotna; and

WHEREAS, the provisions of KPB 21.72 providing for regulation of zoning within the City of Soldotna will not be required for that purpose after the delegation of zoning power to the City of Soldotna;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That pursuant to the authority contained in AS 29.33.070(b)(2), the Kenai Peninsula Borough Assembly hereby delegates to the City of Soldotna the zoning powers conferred the Kenai Peninsula Borough by AS 29.33.


Section 2. That Kenai Peninsula Borough Chapter 21.72 is hereby repealed.

Section 3. That this ordinance shall take effect at 12:01 a.m. on May 22, 1985 or as soon thereafter as the Assembly approves.
