KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH

ORDINANCE 85-26

PROVIDING FOR A SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION OF \$40,000 TO THE LEGAL DEPARTMENT BUDGET.

WHEREAS, Kenai Peninsula Borough has prosecuted suit against the State of Alaska challenging the State's reapportionment plan; and

WHEREAS, during fiscal year 1984-85 Borough's expended approximately \$61,000 for legal services in that case; and

WHEREAS, it's anticipated that there are further billings from counsel handling that case in the approximate amount of \$25,000; and

WHEREAS, these expenses have exceeded the \$45,000 budgeted; and

WHEREAS, there are insufficient funds in the contract services account for legal department to pay for these services;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the sum of \$40,000 is hereby appropriated from the general fund unappropriated balance to account number 100-113010-43011.


Section 2. That this ordinance takes effect immediately upon its enactment.
