ORDINANCE 85-38

AMENDING KPB 2.08.084 TO CLARIFY ASSEMBLY AGENDA PREPARATION DEADLINES.

WHEREAS, ordinances of the Kenai Peninsula Borough do not specifically provide for the mayor to place ordinances, resolutions and other items of business to be introduced and considered by the borough assembly on the agenda; and

WHEREAS, by practice the Wednesday deadline for the placing of items on the agenda has been dispensed with and the dates of actual practice should be codified; and

WHEREAS, the assembly should be provided advance notice of titles of proposed legislation so that they may commence research before receiving the official packet if they deem it necessary; and

WHEREAS, the borough clerk is presently receiving a great number of legislative items for inclusion on the agenda on Monday and Tuesday of the week following the present deadline thereby reducing the time available for her to perform her other duties;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That KPB 2.08.080 is hereby amended as follows:

2.08.084 Agenda--Introduction of ordinances and resolutions. A. Ordinances, resolutions and other items of business to be introduced and considered by the borough assembly at a regular meeting of the assembly shall be placed on a meeting agenda prepared by the borough clerk.

B. At the time that proposed legislation is ready for introduction and consideration of the assembly, the Mayor, an assembly member, or committee of the assembly proposing to place a legislative matter on the agenda of a regular assembly meeting shall provide a copy of such matter to [INFORM] the borough clerk by 4:30 p.m. of the second Thursday [WEDNESDAY] preceding the meeting at which the matter is to be introduced or considered for assignment of the next sequential number in the order received so that an outline agenda containing the titles and numbers of such matters can be mailed to each assembly member and to the newspapers on the clerks mailing list at the close of business that day.

C. Any items not placed on the agenda by the three o'clock deadline [THAT TIME] shall be deferred until the next assembly meeting, unless the assembly votes to consider the item pursuant to Section 2.08.100.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its enactment.
