## ORDINANCE 85-51 (AMENDED)

AUTHORIZING INDEBTEDNESS BY THE ISSUANCE OF GENERAL OBLIGATION BONDS IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$83,575,000, FOR THE PURPOSE OF ACQUIRING, DESIGNING, MANAGING, INSPECTING, IMPROVING, CONSTRUCTING AND EQUIPPING THE CENTRAL PENINSULA HIGH, NIKISKI HIGH, KENAI ELEMENTARY, NIKISKI ELEMENTARY, HOPE SCHOOL AND ADDITION TO SOLDOTNA ELEMENTARY SCHOOL, AND PLEDGING FULL FAITH AND CREDIT OF THE BOROUGH, WITH PAYMENT OF THE INDEBTEDNESS TO BE DERIVED FROM TAXES LEVIED WITHIN THE BOROUGH, AND SUBJECT TO APPROVAL BY THE VOTERS AT THE REGULAR ELECTION ON OCTOBER 1, 1985.

WHEREAS, the continuing educational demands make additional school facilities necessary to alleviate overcrowding and to accommodate the needs; and

WHEREAS, Nikiski, Soldotna, Kenai and Hope require new facilities and additions; and

WHEREAS, new high schools are needed in Nikiski and in Soldotna; and

WHEREAS, new elementary schools are needed at Nikiski, Kenai and Hope;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH.

Section 1. That indebtedness in the form of General Obligation bonds in an amount not to exceed \$83,575,000 may be incurred by the Borough for the purpose of raising funds for acquisition, design, Project management, inspection, improving, equipping, and constructing the following school capital projects, in the specified amounts.

- 1. New Kenai Elementary School in the amount of \$8.570,000.
- 2. New Nikiski Elementary School in the amount of \$8,425,000.
- 3. New Hope School in the amount of \$3,720,000.
- 4. New Nikiski High School in the amount of \$30,240,000.
- 5. New Central Peninsula High School in the amount of \$28,215,000.
- 6. Soldotna Elementary School addition and renovations

 $\underline{\text{Section 2}}.$  That payment of indebtedness shall be derived from taxes levied within the Borough without limitation of rate or amount and from such other revenues as may be properly pledged for such payment, with full faith and credit of the Borough pledged to the repayment of the indebtedness.
