KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH

ORDINANCE 85-64

PLACING ON THE BALLOT AT THE NEXT GENERAL ELECTION QUESTIONS AS TO WHETHER THE MUNICIPAL OFFICERS AND COMMISSIONERS OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH SHALL BE EXEMPT FROM THE FINANCIAL DISCLOSURE LAW AND FROM THE ELECTION CAMPAIGN FUND DISCLOSURE LAW.

WHEREAS, the state law requires all municipal officers, including the mayor, assemblymen, school board members, and members of the planning commission, to file reports concerning finances; and

WHEREAS, the state law also requires all candidates for borough elective offices to file reports of campaign contributions and expenditures; and

WHEREAS, AS 39.50.145 provides that the voters may exempt municipal officers and elected officials of the borough from the filing of the conflict of interest statements and campaign reports; and

WHEREAS, the Assembly of the Kenai Peninsula Borough desires that the voters of the Borough be given the opportunity to decide whether or not either or both of these laws should be applicable to public offices within the Borough;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That there shall be placed on the ballot for the regular borough election of October 7, 1986, the following proposition:

"Shall candidates for and members of all appointed or elected commissions of the Kenai Peninsula Borough be exempt from all reporting and disclosure requirements of the Alaska Conflict of Interest Law (AS 39.50)?"

Section 2. That there shall be placed on the ballot for the regular borough election of October 7, 1986, the following proposition:

"Shall candidates or officeholders for Assembly, Mayor and School Board of the Kenai Peninsula Borough and School District be exempt from all reporting and disclosure requirements of the Alaska Conflict of Interest Law (AS 39.50)?"

Section 3. That this ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
