KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH

ORDINANCE 85-68

APPROVING THE TRADE OF BOROUGH OWNED LAND IN THE NIKISKI AREA FOR SALAMATOF NATIVE CORPORATION OWNED LAND IN THE NIKISKI AREA TO BE USED BY THE KENAI PENINSULA SCHOOL DISTRICT AS AN ELEMENTARY SCHOOL SITE FOR THE 1985 BOND ISSUE.

WHEREAS, the Kenai Peninsula Borough Assembly adopted Resolution 85-69 on May 7, 1985 authorizing the negotiations for trade between the Borough and Salamatof Native Corporation; and

WHEREAS, the Borough received patent on February 2, 1973 to that land within a portion of Government Lot 6, Section 11, T6N, R12W, S.M., AK containing 22.1 acres more or less; and

WHEREAS, the Salamatof Native Corporation has received patent to the E $\frac{1}{2}$ E $\frac{1}{2}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 36, T7N, R12W, S.M., Alaska containing 25.7 acres more or less; and

WHEREAS, the Borough and Salamatof Native Corporation are in agreement to trade the above described land at equal value;


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the exchange of the above described lands between the Borough and Salamatof Native Corporation is hereby authorized.


Section 2. That the Mayor is empowered to enter into an agreement for exchange of that property and sign such documents necessary to effectuate this ordinance and deemed to be in the Borough's best interest.

Section 3. That this ordinance takes effect immediately upon its enactment.
