ORDINANCE 85-76

AMENDING KPB 4.10.020 REGARDING RESIDENCY REQUIREMENTS FOR CANDIDATES FOR BOROUGH ASSEMBLY AND SERVICE AREA BOARDS.

WHEREAS, KPB 4.10.020 regarding candidate qualifications requires that candidates for Borough assembly and for service area boards must be qualified voters of the Borough and a resident of the district or service area in which he or she runs; and

WHEREAS, the assembly believes that the purpose of the residency requirement would be better served by requiring a candidate to reside in the appropriate area for at least sixty (60) days prior to the filing deadline for candidacy for the respective positions;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That KPB 4.10.020 is amended as follows:

4.10.020 Candidate qualifications. A. Candidates for all elected offices [BOROUGH MAYOR AND SCHOOL BOARD] must be qualified voters of the borough.

B. Candidates for borough assembly member must be qualified voters of the borough and a resident of the district in which he or she runs.

C. Candidates for service area boards must be qualified voters of the borough and a resident[S] of the service area[.] for a minimum of sixty (60) days prior to the deadline for filing for the office sought.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its enactment.
