KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH

ORDINANCE 85-81 (SUBSTITUTE)

AMENDING ORDINANCE 84-43 (SUBSTITUTE) TO PROVIDE FOR AN EARLIER EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Ordinance 84-43 (Substitute), establishing the Kalifornsky Fire Service Area, provided for an effective date of July 1, 1986; and

WHEREAS, there is a need for the service area to begin organizing and applying for State funds and grants as soon as practical for the earliest provision of fire protection services;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That Section 2 of Ordinance 84-43 (Substitute) is amended to read as follows:

Section 2. That this ordinance takes effect [ON JULY 1, 1986] upon enactment of Ordinance 85-81 (Substitute), only after approval by the voters of the service area at the regular Borough election to be held on October 1, 1985; except that KP.B. 16.64.080 (G) setting a 2 mill limit, takes effect [ON JULY 1, 1986] upon enactment of Ordinance 85-81 (Substitute), only after approval by the voters of the service area voting on the question of the mill limit at the regular borough election to be held on October 1, 1985, except that the actions of the service area will be limited to the following until such time as funds are available and appropriated for fire protection services:

1. Organization of the fire service area;
2. applications for funding; and
3. volunteer recruitment and classroom (Non-equipment) training.

Section 2. That this ordinance takes effect immediately upon its enactment.
