KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH

ORDINANCE 85-85

APPROPRIATING \$31,000 OF FEDERAL REVENUE SHARING FUNDS FOR THE PURCHASE OF ASBESTOS ABATEMENT EQUIPMENT AND ONE MICROFILM READER/PRINTER FOR USE IN THE PLANNING DEPARTMENT.

WHEREAS, two inspections per year are required of those Borough buildings containing asbestos materials; and

WHEREAS, the Borough is required by EPA and OSHA regulations to protect any employees engaged in decreasing the hazards of asbestos in Borough-owned buildings; and

WHEREAS, safety equipment is needed to protect these employees; and

WHEREAS, the microfilm reader/printer used in the Planning Department for reading and printing subdivision plats is no longer functioning properly; and

WHEREAS, it is more economical to purchase a new machine than to continue with costly maintenance and attempts to repair the machine; and

WHEREAS, an administrative public hearing was held at 5 p.m. on October 16, 1985, and no adverse comments were heard from the public regarding this appropriation;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That \$31,000 is hereby appropriated from the Federal Revenue Sharing Fund unappropriated balance to the following accounts for the following purposes:

Acct. No. 245-410010-48510 - \$10,000
Purchase of safety equipment to be used for the abatement of asbestos hazard in Borough-owned buildings.

Acct. No. 245-411010-48120 - \$21,000
Purchase of one microfilm reader/printer to be used in the Borough Planning Department.

Section 2. That this ordinance takes effect immediately upon its enactment.
