ORDINANCE 85-96

AMENDING KPB 2.08.130 TO DEFINE WHEN PUBLIC COMMENT IS ALLOWED AT BOROUGH ASSEMBLY MEETINGS.

WHEREAS, it is necessary to define more precisely when members of the public may make presentations or testify at Borough assembly meetings; and

WHEREAS, it is the intent of the assembly that members of the public may make presentations or testify at the time of introduction and consideration of resolutions, and at the time of public hearing on ordinances;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That KPB 2.08.130(A) is amended to read as follows:

2.08.130 Public presentations--Requirements. A. A public presentation or public testimony may be made without prior notice concerning resolutions [LEGISLATION] then being considered by the assembly and at public hearings on ordinances [IN THE FORM OF AN ORDINANCE OR RESOLUTION WHEN] at the time the assembly considers such resolution or at the public hearing of such ordinance [THE SPECIFIC LEGISLATIVE ITEMS], or as otherwise provided by the assembly. The time allowed for individual public presentations is 3 minutes, whether individually or by agent, but not both; provided, however, that any assembly member may request privilege to permit an additional 3 minutes of individual public presentation by any individual concerning that legislative item. The 3-minute limitation shall be strictly enforced by the president.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its enactment.
