KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH
ORDINANCE 86-3 (SUBSTITUTE)

ESTABLISHING A POLICY ON LOCAL HIRE.

WHEREAS, the Alaska Department of Labor, in its January 1986 Economic Trends, reports a 14.9 percent rate of unemployment among residents of the borough; and

WHEREAS, the borough has a compelling interest in reducing the level of unemployment among its residents; and

WHEREAS, the assembly believes that jobs funded in whole or in part by local taxes should be filled by local people;


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the Kenai Peninsula Borough Code of Ordinances is amended by adding a new section that shall read as follows:

18.05.010 Intent--Local hire policy. It is hereby declared to be the policy of the assembly of the Kenai Peninsula Borough that qualified and available residents of the borough shall be given employment preference over non-residents for all jobs funded in whole or in part by local taxes.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its enactment.
