ORDINANCE 86-6

PROVIDING FOR AN ELECTED BOARD FOR THE CENTRAL KENAI PENINSULA HOSPITAL SERVICE AREA.

WHEREAS, AS 29.63.090(c) states that the assembly may provide for appointed or elected boards to supervise the furnishing of special services in service areas; and

WHEREAS, of the thirteen service areas in the Borough, all have elected boards except for the Central Kenai Peninsula Hospital Service Area (CKPHSA); and

WHEREAS, the assembly finds that it is desirable to provide for an elected board for the CKPHSA;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That KPB 16.08.020 is amended to read as follows:

- 16.08.020 Board--Established--Meetings [MEMBER-SHIP]. A. There is established a [HOSPITAL] board of directors for the Central Kenai Peninsula Hospital Service Area composed of 9 members who shall be [NOMI-NATED] elected by the qualified voters of the service area in the manner provided for candidates for the assembly in the Borough Code of Ordinances, except that members of the board shall be residents of the borough within the service area [BY THE BOROUGH MAYOR AND APPOINTED BY THE ASSEMBLY].
- B. The board shall meet periodically at regular and special meetings called by the board. All meetings shall be open to the public as provided by law.
- $\underline{Section~2}.$ That board members sitting at the effective date of this ordinance shall serve their full terms. An election shall be held to fill the seat vacated by such board member.
- $\underline{\text{Section 3}}.$ That this ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its enactment.
