ORDINANCE 86-43

AMENDING KPB 2.08.120 REGARDING THE ORDER OF BUSINESS AT BOROUGH ASSEMBLY MEETINGS TO ALLOW PUBLIC COMMENTS AND PUBLIC PRESENTATIONS TO BE MADE IMMEDIATELY FOLLOWING LEGISLATIVE BUSINESS AND FORMAL PRESENTATION.

WHEREAS, the order of business for assembly meetings is set out by KPB Ordinance 2.08.120 which currently allows for Mayor's report, other business, and assembly and Mayor's comments prior to public comments and public presentations; and

WHEREAS, experience has shown that typically legislative business is not completed until very near the midnight deadline leaving the public comments and public presentations to the early hours of the next morning; and

WHEREAS, the assembly wishes to encourage public comments and public presentations and believes that reordering business to allow public comments and public presentations immediately following legislative business and formal presentations would provide some encouragement to the public to remain at the meetings long enough to air their views;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That KPB Ordinance 2.08.120 is amended by reordering subsections "N" through "Q" to read as follows:

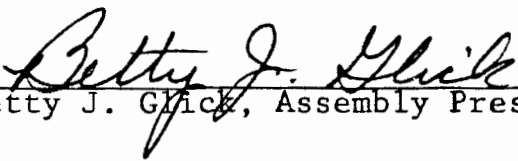
- N. Public comments and public presentations upon matters not contained in the assembly's agenda for the meeting;
- O. Mayor's report;
- P. Other business;
- Q. Assembly and mayor's comments;

with all other subsections of Section 2.08.120 to remain in their current order with their current letter designation.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its enactment.
