KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH

ORDINANCE 86-46

APPROPRIATING \$45,000 TO THE BEAR CREEK FIRE SERVICE AREA TO BE REPAID IN THREE, \$15,000 INSTALLMENTS FROM THE TAX LEVIES OF FISCAL 1987, 1988, AND 1989.

WHEREAS, the Bear Creek Fire Service Area received a state grant for \$50,000 for purchase of a tanker during the 1985/86 fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, due to a mix up in the accounting procedures on the Bear Creek Fire Service Area, the service area was mistakenly shown to have \$45,000 in its fund balance when, in fact, that grant money was also accounted for in a future receivables account since the monies were not expended during the fiscal year and the grant by its terms could not be paid by the state unless the funds were expended; and

WHEREAS, due to this situation the Bear Creek Fire Service Area allocated and spent funds beyond their fund balance raising a debt by the service area of \$45,000 to the Kenai Peninsula Borough general fund; and

WHEREAS, requiring repayment of the entire \$45,000 debt in the next fiscal year would result in an increase in mill rate of the Bear Creek Fire Service Area from .5 mills to 4.0 mills at a time when the borough mill rate is also increasing by a large amount;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That \$45,000 be appropriated from the general fund balance, account #100-949-010-47207 to the Bear Creek Fire Service Area fund, account #207-38100 to zero out the current negative balance in the service area fund account.

Section 2. That this \$45,000 is to be repaid through the tax levies in the Bear Creek Fire Service Area to the general fund through three equal installments of \$15,000 in the fiscal years 1986/87, 1987/88 and 1988/89.

Section 3. That this ordinance shall take effect on June 30, 1986.
