KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH

ORDINANCE 86-47 (SUBSTITUTE)

ESTABLISHING BID PROCEDURES TO REQUIRE THE PRESENCE OF THE PUBLIC WORKS DIRECTOR AND THE FINANCE DIRECTOR AT ALL BID OPENINGS FOR PROJECTS OVER \$250,000 TO DETERMINE QUALIFICATIONS OF BIDDERS.

WHEREAS, the assembly believes that it is important to establish for the public the fact that procedures involving bid opening and award are fair to all bidders; and


WHEREAS, a determination as to the qualification of bidders should be made at the earliest possible moment in order to avoid confusion and disagreement as to the bid award;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:


Section 1. That at all future bid openings on contracts over \$250,000 let by the Kenai Peninsula Borough, the borough public works director and the borough finance director must be present to open bids and determine acceptability of bidder response.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its enactment.
