ORDINANCE 86-51

AMENDING KPB 2.12.080 TO DELETE ASSEMBLY CAR ALLOWANCE.

WHEREAS, the borough assembly, on June 5, 1986, voted to pass Ordinance 86-37 appropriating funds for the borough for fiscal year 1986/87; and

WHEREAS, in amending Ordinance 86-37 as introduced by the Mayor, the assembly made a line item amendment which specifically deleted appropriation for payment of car allowance for assembly members; and

WHEREAS, while this action does have the effect deleting any appropriation of funds to pay the car allowance, the KPB Code of Ordinances, in Section 2.12.080(B) currently states that assembly members shall receive an allowance of \$150 per month for use of their personal automobile;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That KPB 2.12.080 is amended as follows:

- 2.12.080 Compensation -- Per diem and travel expenses. A. For travel involved in attending scheduled meetings of the assembly or in attending meetings as a member of a special committee, assembly members shall receive reimbursement for per diem and travel expenses on the same basis as borough employees.
- B. Assembly members (SHALL RECEIVE AN ALLOWANCE OF \$150.00 PER MONTH FOR USE OF THE PERSONAL AUTOMOBILE ON BOROUGH BUSINESS, AND) shall be reimbursed for mileage recorded on authorized borough business trips at the rate of \$.4% per mile.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
