ORDINANCE 86-56

AMENDING KPB 5.04.060 TO CORRECT APPROPRIATIONS PROCEDURE AND AMENDING KPB 5.04.080 TO PERMIT PUBLIC HEARINGS FOR EMERGENCY APPROPRIATIONS AND AMENDING KPB 5.04.100 BY ADDING A NEW SUBSECTION "D" TO DEDICATE CERTAIN BUDGET LINE ITEMS.

WHEREAS, the Mayor presents the annual Kenai Peninsula Borough budget to the assembly each fiscal year for line item approval; and

WHEREAS, Title 29 requires appropriations to be by ordinance rather than by resolution as the borough code presently provides; and

WHEREAS, the borough code presently provides that appropriations for emergencies do not require public hearing; and

WHEREAS, the assembly believes that certain line items within the annual borough budget should be dedicated to those line items only;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That KPB 5.04.060 is hereby amended to read as follows:

5.05.060 Budget proposal--Adoption required when--Appropriation authority. Following public hearing and before setting the mill levy [AFTER THE PUBLIC HEARING, ON THE SAME DAY OR ANOTHER DAY FOLLOWING THE HEARING, AND NOT LESS THAN 10 DAYS PRIOR TO THE END OF THE FISCAL YEAR], the assembly in regular or special meeting shall by ordinance [RESOLUTION], adopt a budget for the following year and make an appropriation of the money needed therefor.

Section 2. That KPB 5.04.080 is hereby amended to read as follows:

5.04.080 Emergency appropriations. The assembly may make emergency appropriations to meet public emergencies affecting life, health, welfare or property, by ordinance [RESOLUTION], without notice of public hearing. The emergency shall be clearly stated in the preamble [OF THE RESOLUTION. AN EMERGENCY APPROPRIATION RESOLUTION] and is effective upon
