KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH

ORDINANCE 86-63

REMOVING THE REQUIREMENT TO PUBLISH CURRENTLY REGISTERED SALES TAX ACCOUNTS.

WHEREAS, there are in excess of four thousand sales tax accounts; and

WHEREAS, Borough Code, Section 5.18.220B currently requires publication in a newspaper of general or customary circulation in the appropriate area of the borough, a list of all businesses with a then-current certificate of registration; and

WHEREAS, Borough Code, Section 5.18.230 requires publication of non-filing businesses on a quarterly basis; and

WHEREAS, each quarterly publication costs between \$1,500 and \$2,000; and

WHEREAS, the publication of a complete list of all businesses is estimated to cost \$2,500; and

WHEREAS, such a list would not greatly benefit either the businesses published or the public; and

WHEREAS, no additional revenues would be realized to justify publication of this list;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That Borough Code, Section 5.18.220B is hereby deleted in its entirety.

Section 2. That this ordinance takes effect immediately upon its enactment.
