ORDINANCE 86-70

REDUCING ASSEMBLY MEMBER EXPENSE AND CAR ALLOWANCE.

WHEREAS, the mayor has reduced wages and salary costs by 10% because of funding cuts; and

WHEREAS, the assembly should share in this reduction as well;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That KPB 2.12.070 is hereby amended to read:

2.12.070 Compensation--Additional expenses. [A.] Assembly members [ASSEMBLYMEN] shall receive an allowance for expenses which would otherwise not be reimbursed in the amount of \$180.00 [\$200.00] per month, except the assembly president, who shall receive a similar expense allowance in the amount of \$225.00 [\$250.00] per month.

Section 2. That KPB 2.12.080(B) is hereby amended to read:

2.12.080 Compensation--Per diem and travel expenses. B. Assembly members shall receive an allowance of \$135.00 [\$150.00] per month for use of the personal automobile on borough business, and shall be reimbursed for mileage recorded on authorized borough business trips at the rate of \$.45 per mile.

Section 3. That this ordinance shall take effect at 12:01 a.m., September 1, 1986.
