KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH

ORDINANCE 86-79

AMENDING KP.B 2.04.010 TO REPEAL THE LIMIT OF TERMS FOR BOROUGH MAYOR.

WHEREAS, KP.B 2.04.010 limits the terms that a borough mayor may serve in succession; and

WHEREAS, Alaska Statutes were recently amended to prohibit an assembly from limiting the terms of office of a borough mayor without ratification of the voters; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That KP.B 2.04.010 is hereby amended to read as follows:


2.04.010 Term of office. The term of office of the borough mayor is 3 years. [A PERSON ELECTED TO THE OFFICE OF BOROUGH MAYOR SHALL SERVE NO MORE THAN 2 CONSECUTIVE TERMS. ELECTION TO THE OFFICE OF BOROUGH MAYOR FOR ANY FRACTION OF A TERM IN EXCESS OF 24 MONTHS SHALL BE DEEMED TO BE ELECTION FOR A FULL TERM.]

Section 2. That this ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its enactment.
