ORDINANCE 86-82

AMENDING THE BOROUGH CODE OF ORDINANCES RESPECTING ASSEMBLY AGENDA PREPARATION DEADLINES.

WHEREAS, requiring assembly members to hand carry copies of their resolution or ordinances to the borough clerk can be a burden and an added expense;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:


Section 1. That KPB 2.08.080<sup>4</sup>(B) is amended to read as follows:


B. At the time that proposed legislation is ready for introduction and consideration of the assembly, the Mayor, an assembly member or committee of the assembly proposing to place a legislative matter on the agenda of a regular assembly meeting shall provide or communicate a copy of such matter to the borough clerk by 4:30 p.m. of the second Thursday preceding the meeting at which the matter is to be introduced or considered for assignment of the next sequential number in the order received so that an outline agenda containing the titles and numbers of such matters can be made available to any assembly member and media representative requesting it the following work day [MORNING].

Section 2. That this ordinance takes effect immediately upon its enactment.
