ORDINANCE 86-86

AMENDING THE BOROUGH CODE OF ORDINANCES RESPECTING RECONSIDERATION OF LEGISLATION.

WHEREAS, Mason's Manual of Legislative Procedure (hereinafter called Mason's) has been adopted by the borough assembly for most of its rules of procedure, codified in KPB 2.08.080; and

WHEREAS, Mason's provides at Section 467(4) that "If notice of the motion is given but the motion is not made, the effect of the notice terminates on the next legislative day"; and

WHEREAS, it is desirable to provide a place on the agenda for an assembly member to make a motion to reconsider a piece of legislation that has been acted upon, where proper notice of reconsideration has been given;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1 That KPB Code of Ordinances section 2.08.120 is amended as follows:


- 2.08.120 Order of business. The order of business shall be:
- A. Call to order;
  - B. Pledge of allegiance;
  - C. Invocation;
  - D. Roll call;
  - E. Vacancy, designation or seating of assembly members;
  - F. Approval of minutes of previous meetings;
  - G. Committee reports;
  - H. Motions to reconsider;
  - I. Ordinance hearings or other public hearings;
  - J. Agenda approval and consent agenda adoption;;
  - K.[J.] Introduction of ordinances;
  - L.[K.] Consideration of resolutions;
  - M.[L.] Pending legislation;
  - N.[M.] Formal presentations with prior notice upon matters not on the meeting agenda;
  - O.[N.] Public comments and public presentations upon matters not contained in the assembly's agenda for the meeting;
  - P.[O.] Mayor's report;
  - Q.[P.] Other business;
  - R.[Q.] Assembly and mayor's comments;
