ORDINANCE 86-94

ESTABLISHING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION OF KPB 4.06.040 PROHIBITION ON USE OF PUBLIC MONIES TO ADVOCATE PASSAGE OF A BALLOT PROPOSITION.

WHEREAS, KPB 4.06.040 prohibits the use of public monies to promote the passage of a ballot proposition; and

WHEREAS, no fine or sanction is provided for a violation and such is needed;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the Kenai Peninsula Borough Code of Ordinances is amended to add a new subsection 4.06.040(F) to read as follows:

F. Any person who violates a provision of KPB 4.06.040 A-D shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and be subject to a fine of up to \$300 for each violation. For purposes of this subsection, each distribution or separate expenditure or use of property or personnel prohibited by this section shall constitute a violation.

Section 2. That the heading of KPB 4.06.040 shall be changed to read as follows:

4.06.040 Prohibition on use of public moneys to promote passage of ballot propositions--Penalties for violation.

Section 3. That this ordinance takes effect immediately upon its enactment.
