AMENDING THE BOROUGH CODE OF ORDINANCES TO SET A TAX LEVY LIMIT OF TWO MILLS FOR SERVICE AREA OPERATIONS.

WHEREAS, Alaska statutes provide that the borough assembly may by ordinance establish, operate, alter, or abolish a service area; and

WHEREAS, it is desirable to limit the service area operations tax levy to two mills;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

- $\underline{\text{Section 1}}\colon$ That KPB 16.40.020, setting a one-mill levy limit for Central Peninsula Emergency Medical Service Area, is hereby repealed.
- Section 2. That KPB 16.64.080(G), setting a two-mill levy for Kalifornsky Fire Service Area, is hereby repealed.
- Section 3. That KPB 16.68.080(G), setting a two-mill levy limit for Ridgeway/Sterling Fire Service Area, is hereby repealed.
- Section 4. That a new section KPB 16.04.100 is enacted to read as follows:
 - 16.04.100 Mill levy limit. No tax levy for the operation of any service area shall exceed two mills unless the question of abolishing this two-mill limit is approved by a majority vote of the voters at a regular or special election within the service area.
 - Section 5. That this ordinance takes effect July 1, 1988.
