ORDINANCE 87-21

CLARIFYING THE POWERS EXERCISED IN THE NORTH PENINSULA RECREATION SERVICE AREA.

WHEREAS, the North Peninsula Recreation Service Area was established for the construction and maintenance of recreation services by Ordinance 74-16; and

WHEREAS, service area voters defeated a ballot proposition in October 1979 that would have limited the service area to the operation of a swimming pool facility; and

WHEREAS, since the language of service area powers as currently codified is confusing, it is desirable to clarify the language;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:


Section 1. That KPB 16.16.080 is amended to read as follows:

16.16.080 Board--Powers and duties. [PURSUANT TO THE PROVISIONS OF AS 29.63.090] The board of directors of the service area, subject to assembly approval and appropriation of funds and the provisions of KPB 16.04.001, shall provide for recreation services and programs within the service area and may construct, operate and maintain facilities to provide such services. [HAVE THE POWER TO PROVIDE FOR CONSTRUCTION AND MAINTENANCE OF RECREATION SERVICES WITHIN THE SERVICE AREA AND] The board shall advise the mayor and the assembly concerning the administration and operation of the service area. The board shall promptly furnish accurate and complete copies of minutes of all board meetings to the mayor and assembly.

Section 2. That this ordinance takes effect immediately upon its enactment.
