Section 1. That KPB 2.04.060 shall be amended to reas as follows:

- 2.04.060 Salary. A. Compensation for the borough mayor shall be [79,268] \$65,000 per year.
- B. The mayor's salary may be adjusted at the end of each term of office through the budgeting process preceding the mayoral election.
- Section 2. That this ordinance will take effect at the beginning of the next term of office for the mayor.
