WHEREAS, a grant from the State of Alaska, Department of Community and Regional Affairs, has been offered to the North Peninsula Recreation Service Area for on-the-job training; and

225.611010.40310	Workers Compensation	34.06


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the grant offer by the State of Alaska, Department of Community and Regional Affairs, be accepted by the Mayor.


