KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH

ORDINANCE 87-46

ESTABLISHING A SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION TO THE KENAI PENINSULA
BOROUGH SCHOOL DISTRICT

WHEREAS, budget considerations, including uncertainties of the levels of State funding in support of education, resulted in a severely reduced budget for school operations and programs; and

WHEREAS, this reduction would have a negative and undesirable impact on educational programs including the pupil/teacher ratio, reduction of teachers and aids in Special Education, and the reduction or loss of electives and co-curricular activities; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:


Section 1. That the sum of \$1,341,707 is hereby transferred to the Kenai Peninsula Borough School District from the general fund.

Section 2. That this ordinance takes effect immediately upon its enactment.
