ORDINANCE 87-47

AMENDING THE KPB CODE OF ORDINANCES DEALING WITH ASSEMBLY MEMBER ATTENDANCE.

WHEREAS, it is imperative that assembly members attend assembly meetings so that borough business can be conducted; and

WHEREAS, it is desirable to define what an excused absence means;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That KPB 2.12.070 is amended to read as follows:

2.12.070 Compensation--Additional expenses. A. Assembly members [MEN] shall receive an allowance for expenses which would otherwise not be reimbursed in the amount of \$200 per month, except the assembly president, who shall receive a similar expense allowance in the amount of \$250 per month.

B. The amount of \$100, for each regular assembly meeting missed, shall be withheld from an assembly member's expense allowance when the assembly member misses more than three regular assembly meetings during any 365 day period.

Section 2. That KPB 2.16.010 is amended by adding a new section to read as follows:

C. To qualify for an excused absence an assembly member must notify the assembly president or the borough clerk of the intended absence, before a missed meeting, and specifically state the reason or reasons for requesting that the absence be excused. A request for excused absence may be granted by the assembly president. The decision of the assembly president on the request may be overruled by a majority of the total membership of the assembly.

Section 3. That this ordinance takes effect immediately upon its enactment.
