KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH

ORDINANCE 87-67(SUBSTITUTE)

AMENDING KPB 2.32.020 TO PROVIDE FOR CODIFICATION AND DISTRIBUTION OF NEWLY ADOPTED ORDINANCES WITHIN 30 DAYS

WHEREAS, the codification of ordinances adopted by the Assembly is the responsibility of the Borough Attorney; and

WHEREAS, the codification of ordinances adopted by the Assembly is currently contracted; and

WHEREAS, the contract procedure results in delays of several months during which time the codified borough code available to members of the public and to Assembly members is incorrect; and

WHEREAS, most of the ordinances adopted by the assembly have been typed on the Borough Attorney's word processing equipment or other compatible word processing equipment within the borough capable of storing the information for later word processing requirements; and

WHEREAS, after the initial delay of startup, codification and distribution by the Borough Attorney of each new ordinance within 30 days after enactment by the Assembly would result in a more reliable borough code for the use of the general public and the Assembly;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the Kenai Peninsula Borough Code of Ordinances 2.32.020(G) is hereby amended to read as follows:

2.32.020 Borough Attorney--Powers and duties. The borough attorney shall:

G. Be responsible for the preparation, publication and distribution of the borough code of ordinances within 30 days of enactment, modification or repeal by the assembly;

Section 2. That this ordinance shall take effect 120 days after its enactment.
